We welcome presentations that address a variety of themes connected to CAP, such as social justice movements; global citizenship (both local and national movements); civil and human rights; Aboriginal and Indigenous cultures and rights; social media; visual culture; popular culture; economic events; law and history; gender and sexuality; trauma and memory; affect; diversity and action; consumerism; globalization; representation; first-year experiences; and more.

Presenters are invited to share work in a genre that would be suitable to an academic conference: that may include scholarly research papers, creative or multi-media projects, or presentations that frame other topics (personal experience, community work) within a scholarly context. Presenters may want to share work they have done in their CAP classes, work from related classes, or work that combines their thinking across classes. There are two possible formats for presentations: you may choose to deliver an oral paper OR display a visual or multi-media piece.
